# Articles of Faith

## We Believe...

The words of the original writings of the Old and New Testaments are God-breathed. Therefore, they are inerrant and carry the authority of God (Psalm 12:6; Proverbs 30:5; II Timothy 3:16; II Peter 1:20-21).

The Scriptures we now possess have been preserved by God without significant variation and therefore are the very Word of God (Matthew 5:18; 24:35; John 10:35).
